- Lava lamp in a bottle

Here are the instructions if you would like to make your own lava lamp at home.

Remember to ask permission from your parents first.

What to do

1. Pour the water into the bottle.
2. Use a measuring cup or funnel to slowly pour the vegetable oil into the bottle until it's almost full. ...
3. Add 10 drops of food colouring to the bottle (we like red, but any colour will look great.) ...
4. Break a seltzer tablet in half and drop the half tablet into the bottle. Watch it sink to the bottom.
5. To keep the effect going, just add another piece of tablet. For a true lava lamp effect, shine a flashlight through the bottom of the bottle.

- Blow monsters

You never know what kind of creature you'll end up with!

By using different coloured paints, and using a straw to blow the paint around instead of a paint brush, you get something new and interesting every time.
